YARN

Rowan Big Wool, Cocoon and Alpaca Cotton

A Big Champion 065			
5	6	7	x 100gm
B Coc Mink 830			
3	4	4	x 100gm
C Alp Dark Damson 411			
3	4	4	x 50gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 10mm (no 000) (US 15) needles

TENSION

4½ sts and 6 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 10mm (US 15) needles and yarns A, B and C held together.

Pattern note: All st counts given do NOT include the yfwd's or yrn's made whilst working patt.

BACK AND FRONT (both alike)

Using 10mm (US 15) needles and one strand of each of yarns A, B and C held together cast on 29 [35: 37] sts **loosely**.

Row 1 (RS): K0 [1: 2], P1 [3: 3], *K3, P3, rep from * to last 4 [1: 2] sts, K3 [1: 2], P1 [0: 0].

Row 2: P0 [1: 2], K1 [3: 3], *P3, K3, rep from * to last

4 [1: 2] sts, P3 [1: 2], K1 [0: 0].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until work meas 12 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): *K1, yfwd, rep from * to last st, K1.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (WS): *P1, yrn, drop yfwd of previous row, rep from * to last st, P1.

Row 2: *K1, yfwd, drop yrn of previous row, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont straight until work meas 64 [68: 70] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and funnel neck

Cast off 9 [11: 12] sts **very loosely** at beg of next 2 rows.

11 [13: 13] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next row. 9 [11: 11] sts.

Work a further 5 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off **very loosely**.

SLEEVES

Using 10mm (US 15) needles and one strand of each of yarns A, B and C held together cast on 11 [13: 13] sts **loosely**.

Row 1 (RS): K1 [2: 2], P3, K3, P3, K1 [2: 2].

Row 2: P1 [2: 2], K3, P3, K3, P1 [2: 2].

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib until work meas 7 cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Next row (RS): *K1, yfwd, rep from * to last st, K1.

Beg with row 1, now work in patt as given for back and

front, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of next [3rd: next] and 3 [1: 3] foll 4th rows, then on 0 [1: 0] foll 6th row. 19 [19: 21] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 36 [37: 37] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

MAKING UP

Press as described on the information page.

Join both shoulder/funnel neck seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Mark points along side seam edges 22 [22: 24] cm either side of shoulder seams. Attach sleeves to body between these points by grafting sleeve sts onto row-end edges of back and front.
