### NEEDLES

- 1 pair 3¼mm (no 10) (US 3) needles
- 1 pair 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles
- 4mm (no 8) (US 6) circular needle (if required)

### TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows over patt using 4mm (no 8) (US 6) needles.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**Wyib**=with yarn held at back of work

**Wyif**=with yarn held at front of work

### BACK

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn B, cast on 97 [109: 121: 133: 145] sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

**Row 2:** \* K1, P1, rep from \* to last st, K1.

These 2 rows form moss st.

Work 9 rows more in moss st, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

**Row 12:** Purl.

Break off yarn B.

Change to 4mm (US 6) needles and yarn A. \*\*

Beg with a K row, work 8 rows in st st ending with RS facing for next row.

**Row 9 (RS):** Using yarn C, K1, \* yfwd, sl 5 wyif, ybk, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 10:** Using yarn C, P1, \* ybk, sl 5 wyib, yfwd, P1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 11:** K using yarn A.

**Row 12:** P using yarn A.

**Row 13:** Using yarn A, K3, \* insert needle under loose strands of yarn C and K next st catching in both strands behind st, K5, rep from \* to last 4 sts, insert needle under loose strands of yarn C and K next st catching in both strands behind st, K3.

**Row 14:** P using yarn A.

Using yarn A, work 4 rows in st st.

**Row 19 (RS):** Using yarn C, K1, \* yfwd, sl 3 wyif, ybk, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 20:** Using yarn C, P1, \* ybk, sl 3 wyib, yfwd, P1, rep from \* to end.

Using yarn A, work 12 rows in st st.

**Row 33 (RS):** As row 9.

**Row 34:** As row 10.

**Row 35:** K using yarn A.

**Row 36:** P using yarn A.

**Row 37:** As row 13.

**Row 38:** Using yarn C, P1, \* ybk, sl 2 wyib, yfwd, sl 1 wyif, ybk, sl 2 wyib, yfwd, P1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 39:** Using yarn C, K1, \*yfwd, sl 2 wyif, ybk, sl 1 wyib, yfwd, sl 2 wyif, ybk, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 40:** P using yarn A.

These 40 rows form patt.

Work 26 [30: 32: 36: 38] rows more, ending with RS facing for next row.

(Back should meas 26 [27: 28: 29: 30] cm).

### Shape cap sleeves

Keeping patt correct cast on 24 [26: 28: 28: 28] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 145 [161: 177: 189: 201] sts.

Place marker at each end of last row to denote armhole opening.

Change to 4mm (US 6) circular needle if required.

Cont until sleeve meas 18 [19: 20: 21: 22] cm from markers, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Divide for back neck

**Next row:** Patt 55 [63: 70: 76: 81], turn and leave rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st st neck edge of next 5 rows.

Cast off rem 50 [58: 65: 71: 76] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarns to rem sts, cast off centre 35 [35: 37: 37: 39] sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side reversing shapings.

## FRONT

Work as given for back to \*\*.

Working in patt as given for back throughout and taking inc sts into patt, cont as follows:-

**NB:** When working rows 29 and 30 the end sts will need to be adjusted to accommodate the increased sts.

Work 28 rows.

**Next row:** Patt 26 [32: 38: 44: 50], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 5 times, patt 25 [31: 37: 43: 49].

103 [115: 127: 139: 151] sts.

Work 13 rows.

**Next row:** Patt 29 [35: 41: 47: 53], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 5 times, patt 28 [34: 40: 46: 52].

109 [121: 133: 145: 157] sts.

Work 11 rows.

**Next row:** Patt 32 [38: 44: 50: 56], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 5 times, patt 31 [37: 43: 49: 55].

115 [127: 139: 151: 163] sts.

Work 7 rows.

**Next row:** Patt 35 [41: 47: 53: 59], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 5 times, patt 34 [40: 46: 52: 58].

121 [133: 145: 157: 169] sts.

Cont straight until front matches back to shape cap sleeves.

### Shape cap sleeves

Keeping patt correct cast on 24 [26: 28: 28: 28] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 169 [185: 201: 213: 225] sts.

Place marker at each end of last row to denote armhole opening.

Change to 4mm (US 6) circular needle if required.

Work 26 [22: 20: 30: 28] rows.

**Next row:** Patt 71 [79: 87: 93: 99], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 3 times, patt 70 [78: 86: 92: 98].

173 [189: 205: 217: 229] sts.

Work 13 [13: 13: 17: 19] rows.

**Next row:** Patt 73 [81: 89: 95: 101], inc in next st, (patt 8, inc in next st) 3 times, patt 72 [80: 88: 94: 100].

177 [193: 209: 221: 233] sts.

Cont until 12 [12:16: 16: 18] rows less have been worked than on back to shoulder cast off, ending with RS facing for next row.

### Divide for neck

**Next row:** Patt 58 [66: 74: 80: 86], turn and leave rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st st neck edge of next 6 [6: 4: 4: 4] rows, then 2 [2: 5: 5: 6] foll alt rows.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 50 [58: 65: 71: 76] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarns to rem sts, cast off centre 61 sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side reversing shapings.

## MAKING UP

Press.

Join right shoulder seam using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

### Neck border

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn B, pick up and knit 9 [9: 11: 11: 13] sts down left side of neck, 61 sts from front, 9 [9: 11: 11: 13] sts up right side of neck and 55 [55: 57: 57: 59] sts from back. 134 [134: 140: 140: 146] sts.

**Next row:** Knit.

Cast off on RS.

### Sleeve borders (both alike)

With RS facing using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn B, beg and ending at markers, pick up and knit 88 [92: 97: 101: 106] sts all around sleeve edge.

**Next row:** Knit.

Cast off on RS.
